## Assistant Professor – Grade II (Level 11)

## For Academic Areas in Sl. 1 - 7

- A. Two-year Master's Degree in Business Administration/ PGDM/ M.Com/ MCA/ M.Tech/ CA/ ICWA/ Professional Studies, with first class or equivalent in it and in all previous Board/University examinations **and** PhD (or equivalent doctoral qualification) in the Academic Group applied for. Evidence of research writing in the form of review papers/ research papers/ case studies, etc., would be an advantage. **Or**,
- B. Coursework-based PhD (or equivalent) in the academic group applied for, where at least 90 credits (*one credit is ten contact hours*) were earned during coursework to qualify as a doctoral candidate. And first-class or equivalent at Masters' and all previous Board/University examinations. Evidence of research writing in the form of review papers/ research papers/ case studies, etc., would be an advantage.

#### For Academic Areas in Sl. 8 - 10

A. Master's Degree with at least 55% in Social Sciences/ Social Work/ Development Studies/ International Development/ Public Administration/ Professional Studies and first-class or equivalent in all previous Board/University examinations **and** PhD (or equivalent) in the Academic Group applied for. Evidence of writing in the form of review papers/ research papers/ case studies would be an advantage.

## Assistant Professor - Grade I (Level 12)

Educational Qualification: Same as for Assistant Professor - Grade II

**Experience:** Three years of post-doctoral academic experience (teaching or research or both)

## Associate Professor (Level 13A2)

Educational Qualification: Same as for Assistant Professor Grade-II

### **Experience:**

- A. Eight years of teaching experience at the level of Assistant Professor, of which at least five years at Level 12, **Or**,
- B. Twelve years of relevant industry/ research experience, including at least three years of post-doctoral experience and five years of teaching experience at a level equivalent to an Assistant Professor at Level 12

#### **Publications record:**

Six publications - with the first authorship of at least four, including

- a. Research papers in refereed journals
- b. Cases with teaching notes in recognised case-clearing Journals/repositories
- c. Significant consulting research reports
- d. Book/book chapter

- A. Thirteen years of teaching experience, of which at least five years are at the level of Associate Professor, and eight years post-doctoral experience; **Or**,
- B. Seventeen years of relevant industry/ research experience, including at least eight years post-doctoral experience and five years of teaching experience at a level equivalent to Associate Professor.

Ten publications - with the first authorship of at least six, including

- a. Research papers in refereed journals
- b. Cases with teaching notes in recognised case-clearing Journals/repositories
- c. Significant consulting research reports
- d. Books/book chapter

1	This is an <b>Open Rolling Advertisement.</b> Scrutiny of applications will be done at the end of one month from the publication of the advertisement in print or on 31st January 2024, whichever is later. 2	Scrutiny and Shortlisting will be carried out by the Institute as per requirement, depending on the Academic Groups desired to be filled.
3	Everything else being equal, positive discrimination will apply
4	5% relaxation in educational qualification eligibility for SC/ST/Differently-abled, and 3% for OBC and EWS candidates in Master's degree applicable.
5	Mere fulfilment of minimum eligibility criteria cannot be a claim for shortlisting.
6	The Institute may relax some requirements related to qualification and experience in cases of candidates with exceptional academic and domain expertise in priority areas/fields.
7	All qualifications must be from UGC-recognized Universities/ Deemed Universities or AICTE-approved autonomous institutions (wherever applicable), or foreign Universities/ Institutions of repute.
